Students will have the opportunity to sign-up for five different CCA trials, with at least one from each CCA group. A sign-up link will be shared via Parents Gateway on 9 January 2026 (Fri). Please complete the sign-up process between **9 - 13 January 2026 (Tues)**.

CCA Allocation Exercise

7. To ensure fair allocation, an online CCA option form will be shared through Parents Gateway on 19 January 2026 (Mon), after your child/ward has attended the CCA Fair and Trials. We encourage you to discuss your child's/ward's experiences and choices with them before submitting the online form by **22 January 2026 (Thurs)**.

CCA Allocation Results

8. Students will receive their CCA allocation by 28 January 2026 (Wed), with the first official CCA training session on 29 January 2026 (Mon). Any appeal for CCA changes after allocation will be considered on a case-by-case basis, subject to availability of school resources and validity of the appeal.
